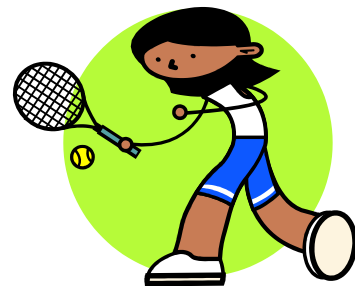

The next course is due to start towards the end of March. Applications forms will be available shortly. Please note there is high demand for places.

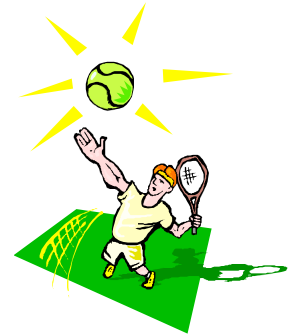
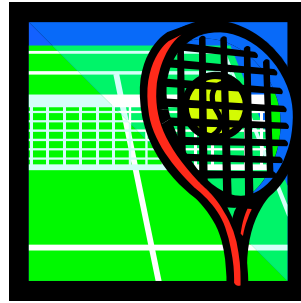
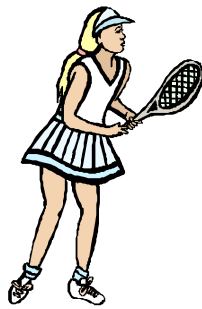
